Staffing update

Suspension of the Multicultural Bulk Loans Service

Due to escalating community transmission of COVID-19, the State Library buildings remain close due to the COVID-19 measures that are in place for the Greater Sydney LGA. The bulk loans service has been suspended since 26 June 2021.

Libraries have been advised to hold off on placing any new orders, and not send back any returns until the team is able to be back onsite at the Library.

We will send a message when we are able to re-start the service.

Renewal of bulk loans

We have been renewing all bulk loans with due dates between 1 May and 31 July 2021.

Long overdue loans

We have contacted some libraries about some long overdue loans to find out if they are lost or returned. Appeal for the return of long overdue titles that are still at the libraries.
