# Multicultural/ ESL collection update

#### Size of the Collection 2022/23

- At the end of 2022/23, there were over **69,000** items in the Multicultural Collection.
- The collection includes books and some audiobooks in 43 different languages plus an English as a Second Language (ESL) collection.
- The Telugu language collection was introduced in April 2022 and the Tibetan language collection was introduced in April 2023.

#### Circulation

- 2022/23 saw the highest demand for Multicultural Bulk Loans over a 5-year period with a total of **75,135 items** circulated.

## **Demand for Bulk Loan Service by Libraries**

- 83 NSW library services made use of our Multicultural Bulk Loan Service in 2022/23.
- They include 82 libraries from the NSW Public Library network and the Metropolitan Remand & Reception Centre (MRRC) Library at Silverwater.

## **English Large Print and Audiobooks Long Term Loans**

- The collection consists of 8,354 large print books and 6,086 audiobooks for adults. We do not have any large print or audiobooks for children.
- There is a mix of CD and MP3 CD material for audiobooks.
- The most popular genres for both formats are detective/mystery, Australian content/authors, romance, family saga, westerns and biographies, historical fiction and action/adventure.
- The accessible format collection is distributed among 56 NSW Public Libraries as long-term loans (1 year and above) to supplement their collections.
- Priority is given to regional NSW public libraries with small operating budgets.
- Many of the libraries use this collection for their Home Library service.
- Stocktake to be conducted in Sep or Oct 2023.
