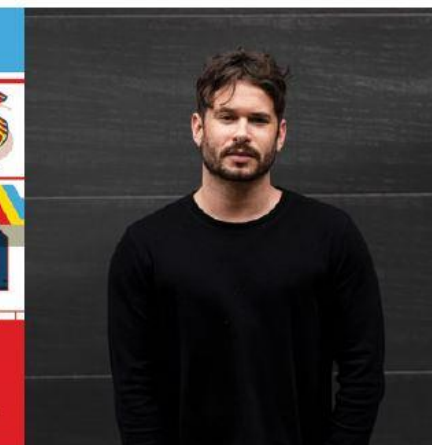
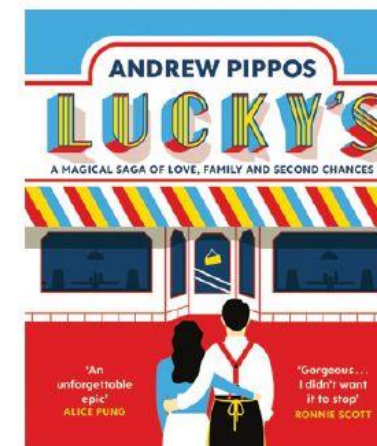

Marti Bracelets

There is a unique Greek tradition during March where people wear red and white bracelets for the entire month.

The Marti bracelet, as it is known, is derived from the Greek word for March.

The bracelet is made of simple thread and is worn to signal the coming of spring. The white symbolises purity while the red stands for life and passion.

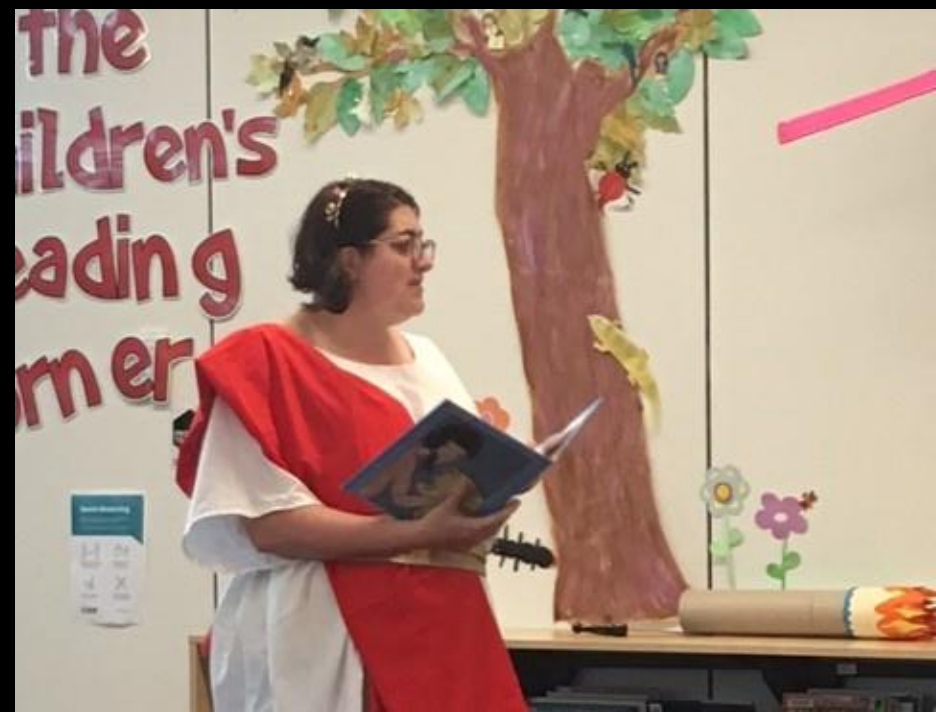


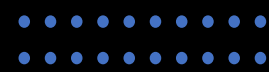
