Sutherland population about 226,000. Growing ageing population. 8 branches – soon to be 9 branches – Kirrawee branch (new build) – Library Plus (recording and podcast studios, screening room, children's library, bookable event space, sound stage/green screen)

Overview of Sutherland Home Library Service – Stephen Peacock

Three full-time staff – Stephen, Kristen and Michelle (Ben helping out while Kristen working in a branch for a few months)

Started in 1968

328 Home Library patrons – 164 in own home, 164 in aged care

20 institutions

No volunteers

2 week cycle -4 deliveries every week (Mon-Thurs each week) - Week 1 and Week 2 = 8 routes Single driver per delivery. Rarely go into the homes.

1 contract courier assists HLS and does interbranch transit

Dedicated Home Library collection – about 10,000 items. Not available for reserves by regular library patrons. Ease and speed of selection.

21,000 loans in 2023

20 Envoys + 15 other

Own budget

Genre labels on everything

DVD collection - about 2000

Deliveries take between 90 minutes and 3.5 hours

Maximum 2 bags per person; maximum 8 books

Courier delivers to 8 nursing homes (4 per week) as well as Bundeena Library

Home Library newsletter (new) includes: local studies info; tech/device info; Top 10 titles; update contact details

Memorandum of Understanding for nursing homes

120/130 turnover per year

Loss rate = less than 1%

No medical certificate required
