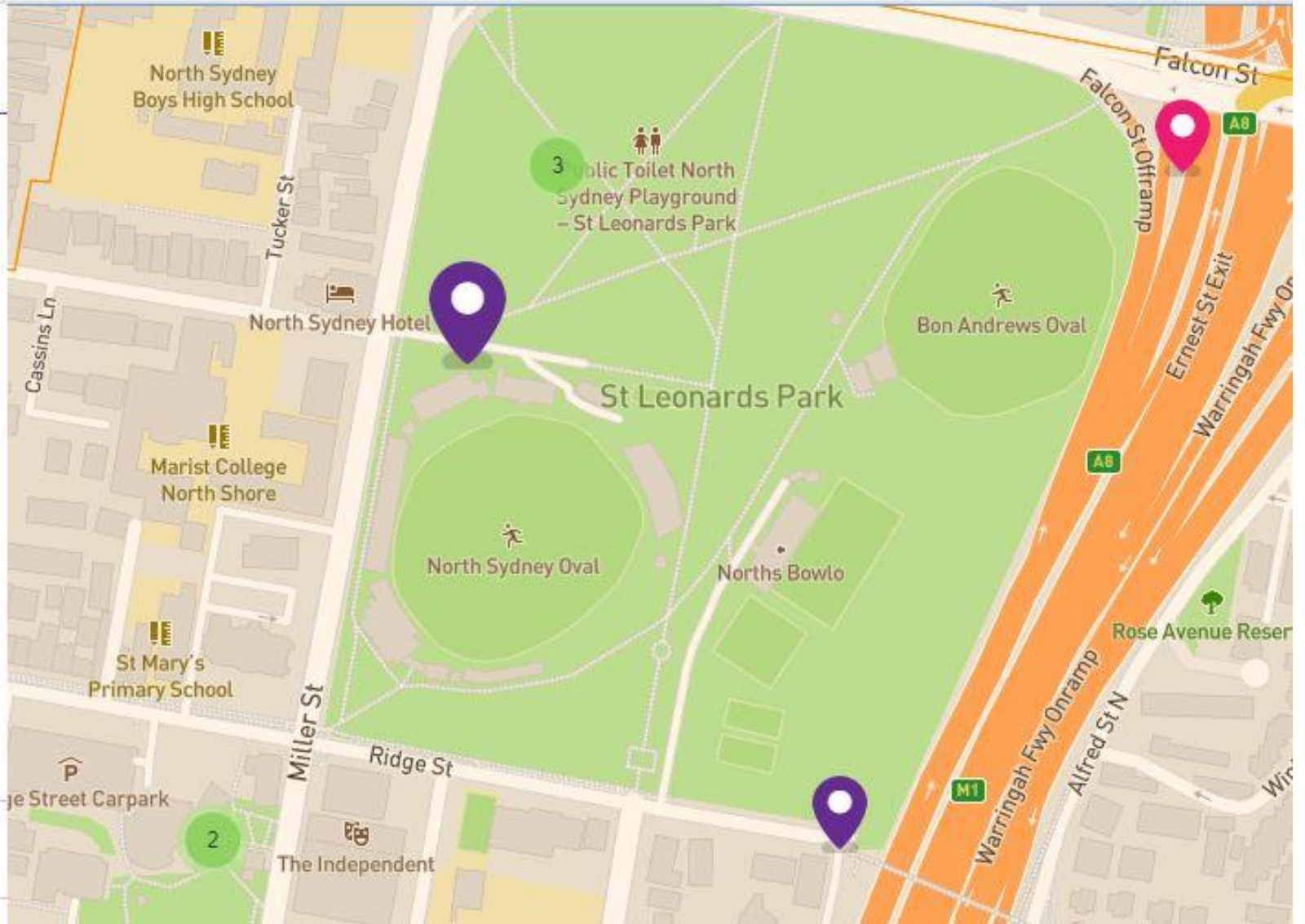

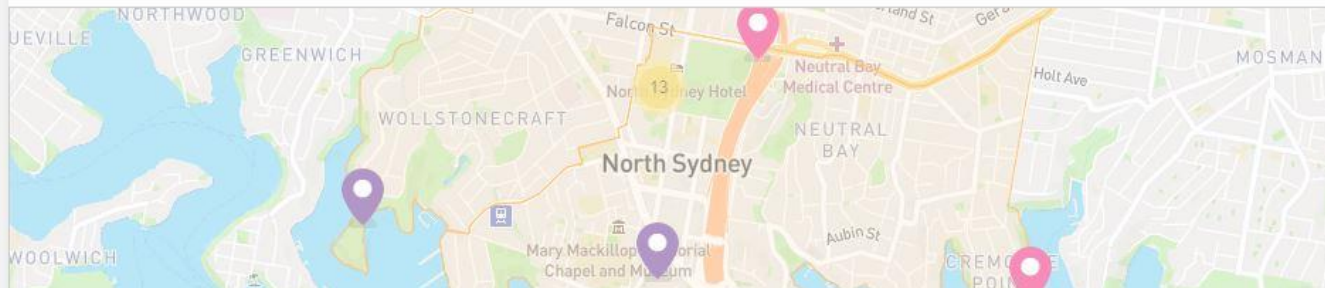

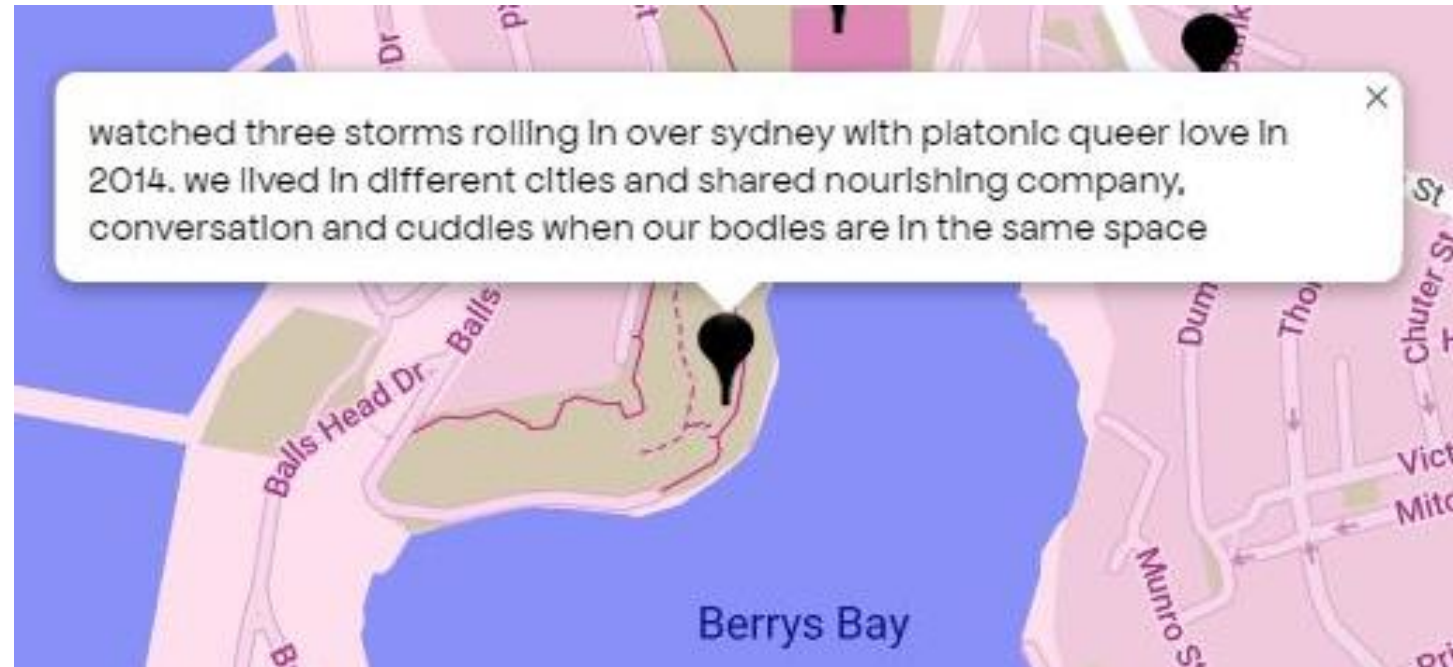

Place a marker pin on the map by clicking on the '+' icon, selecting a pin type, and dragging to your location.



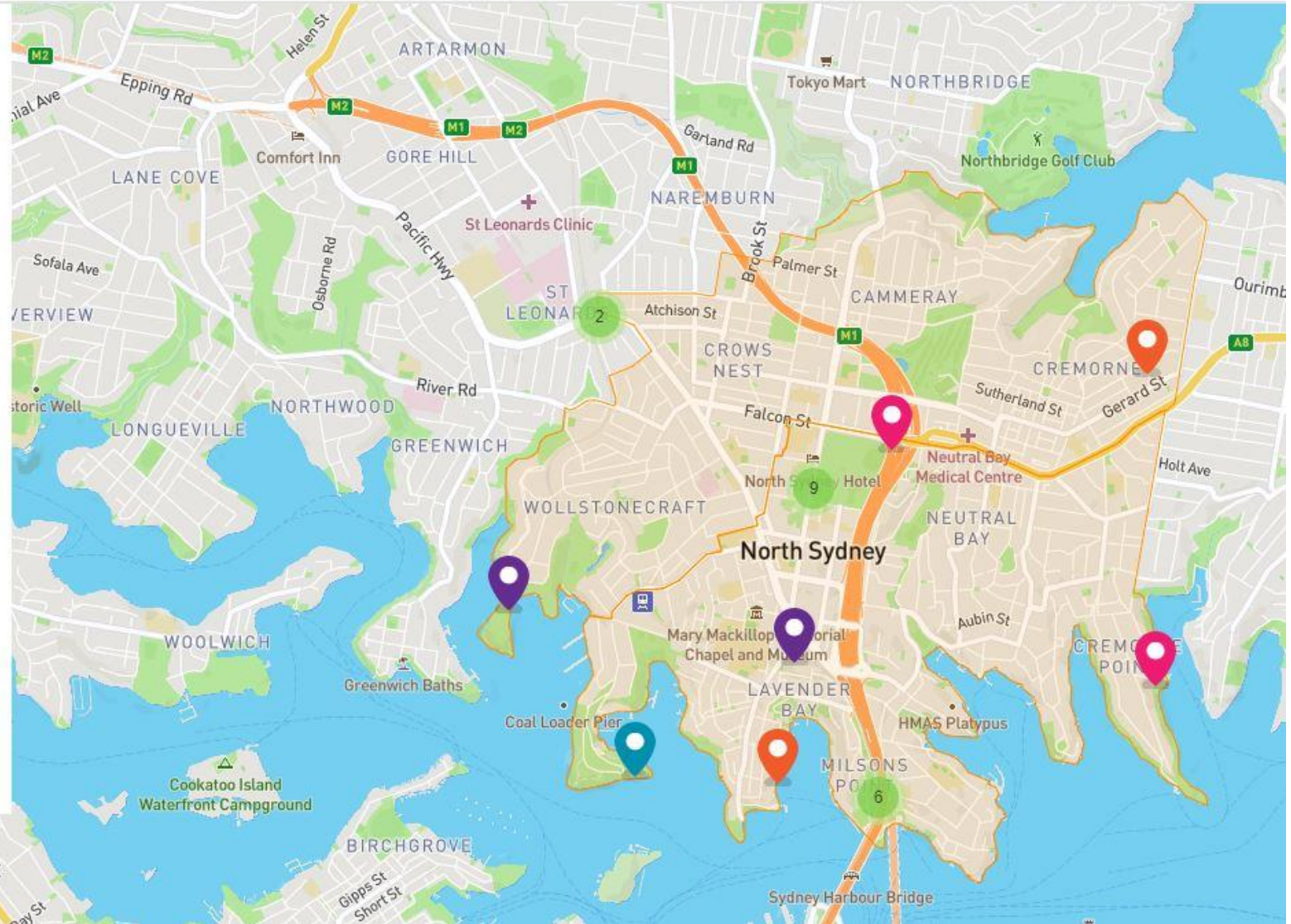
Share your local LGBTIQ+ memory, story, event or feeling. It can be historical or current - and tell us a year if you can.

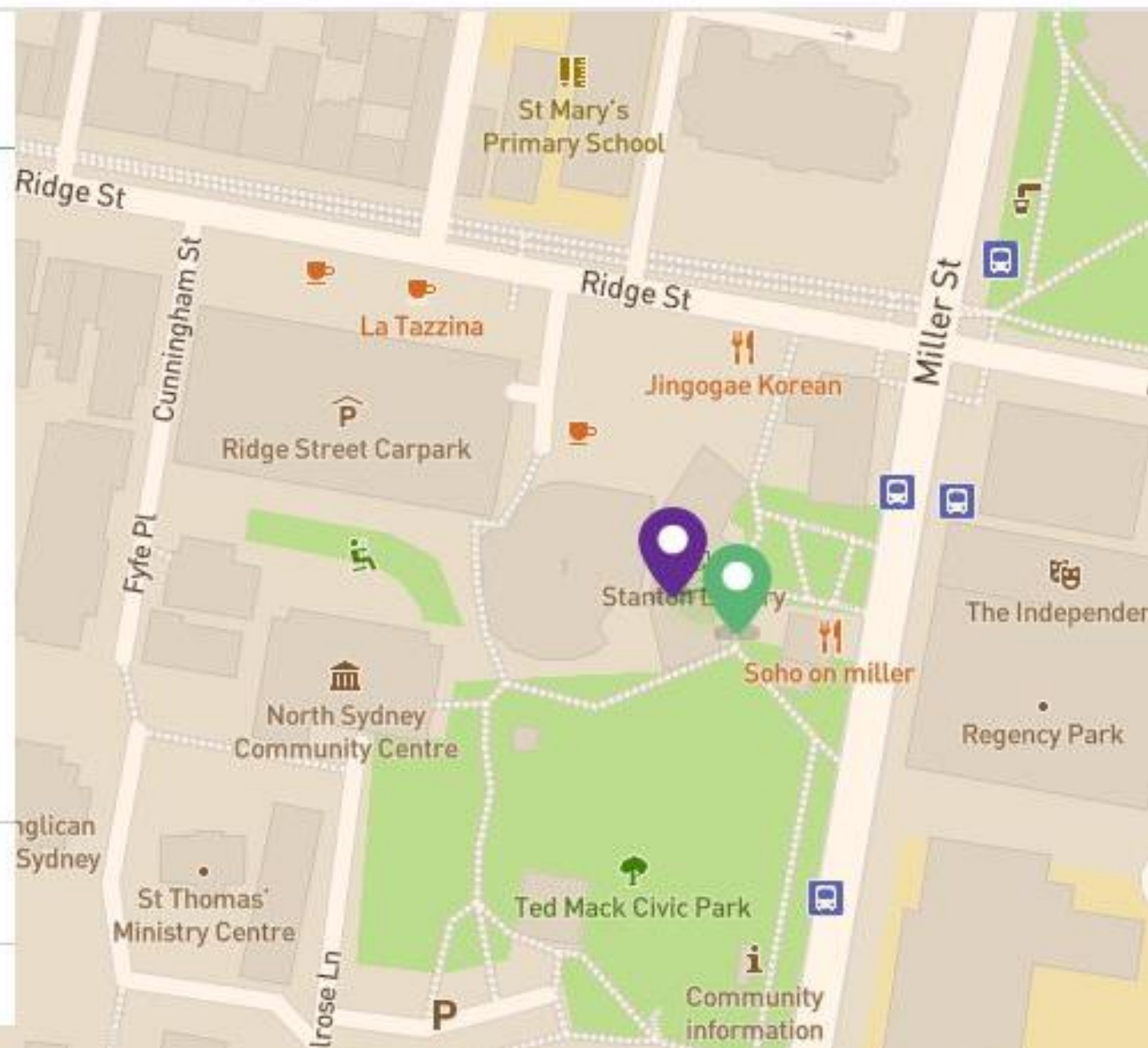

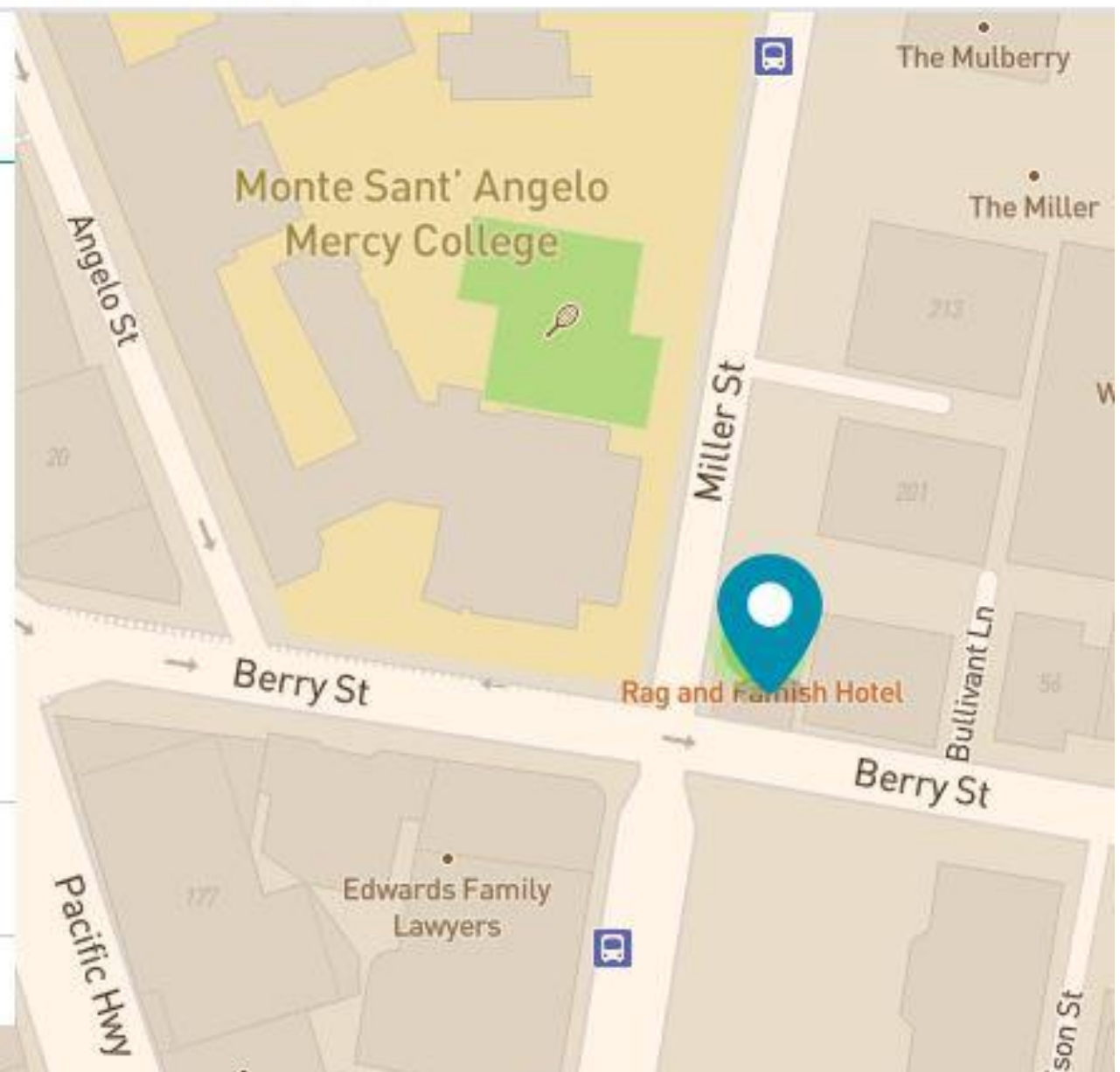

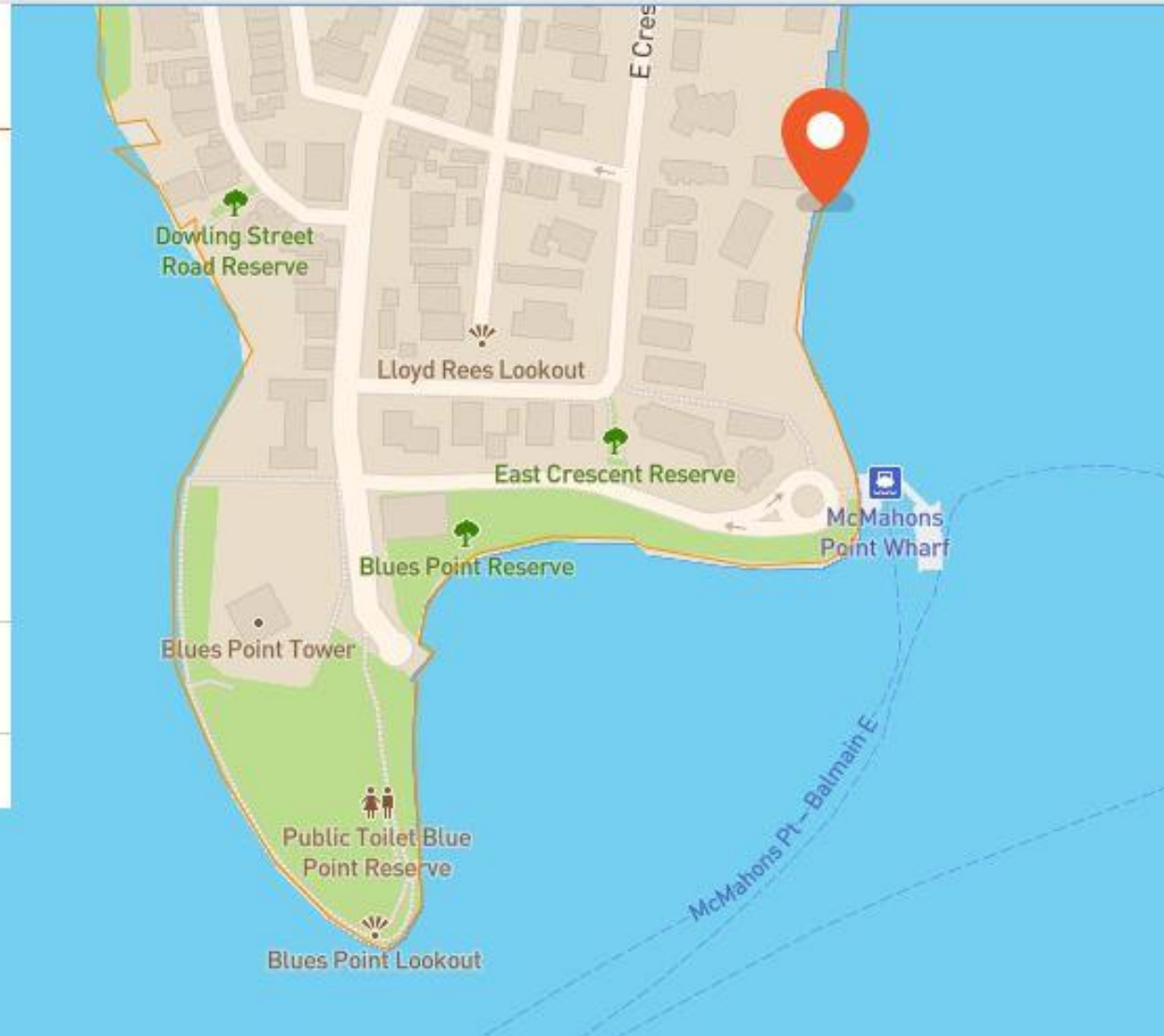
