



- To provide an engaging, thought provoking and easy to access reading program for members to enjoy over summer

- Improved use of digital technology









































Bestselling author of Scrublands and Treasure & Dirt, Chris Hammer, brings his compelling new crime thriller The Tilt to Newcastle.




